“In Case of Emergency”

Referred to as “ICE”, the number gives an emergency responder a telephone number he/she should call in case of emergency. 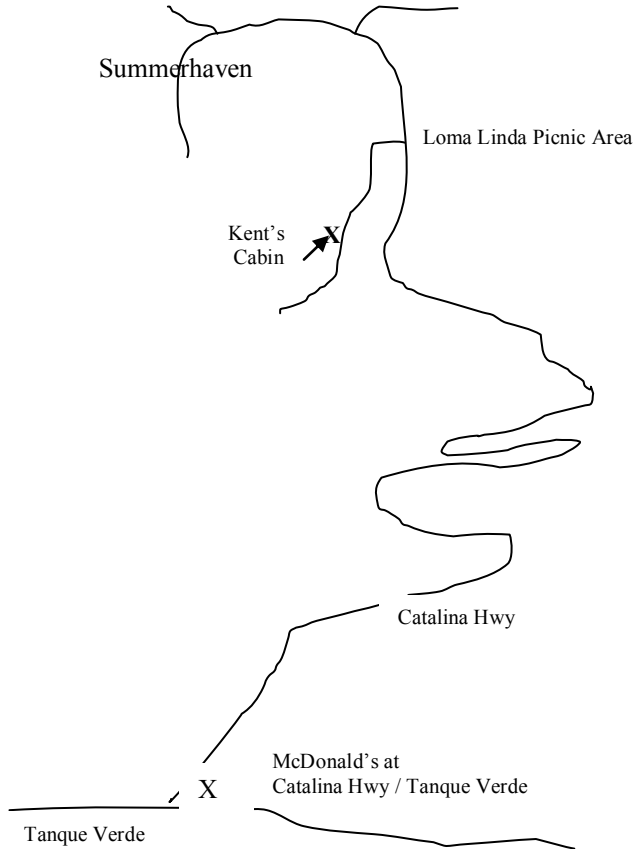

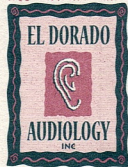


