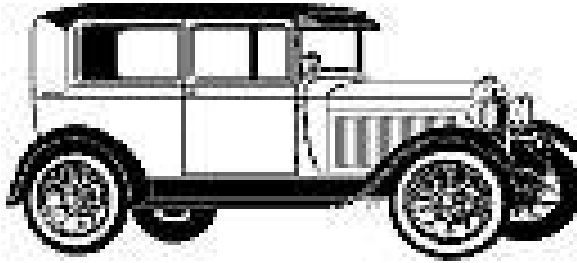

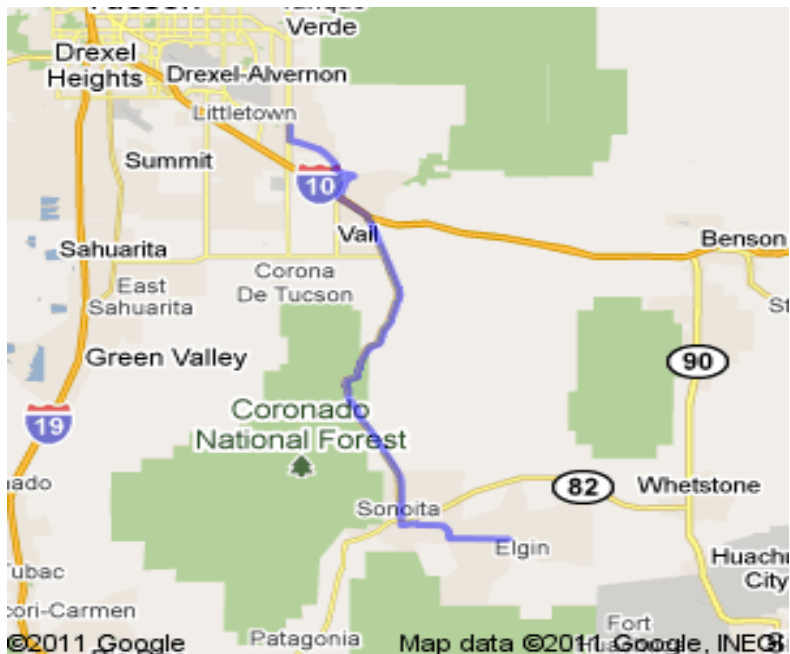


# Kief-Joshua Vineyard
