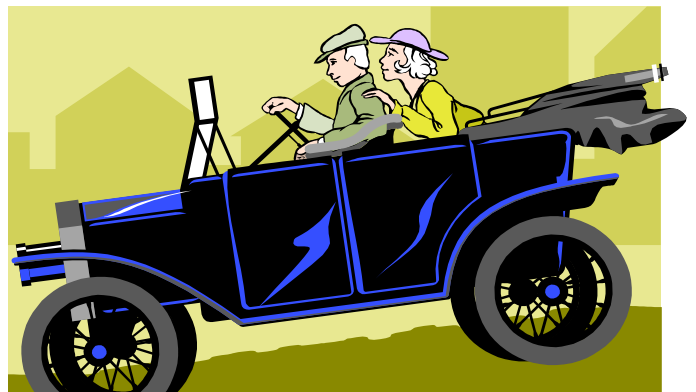
INFORMATION OF INTEREST TO MEMBERS:

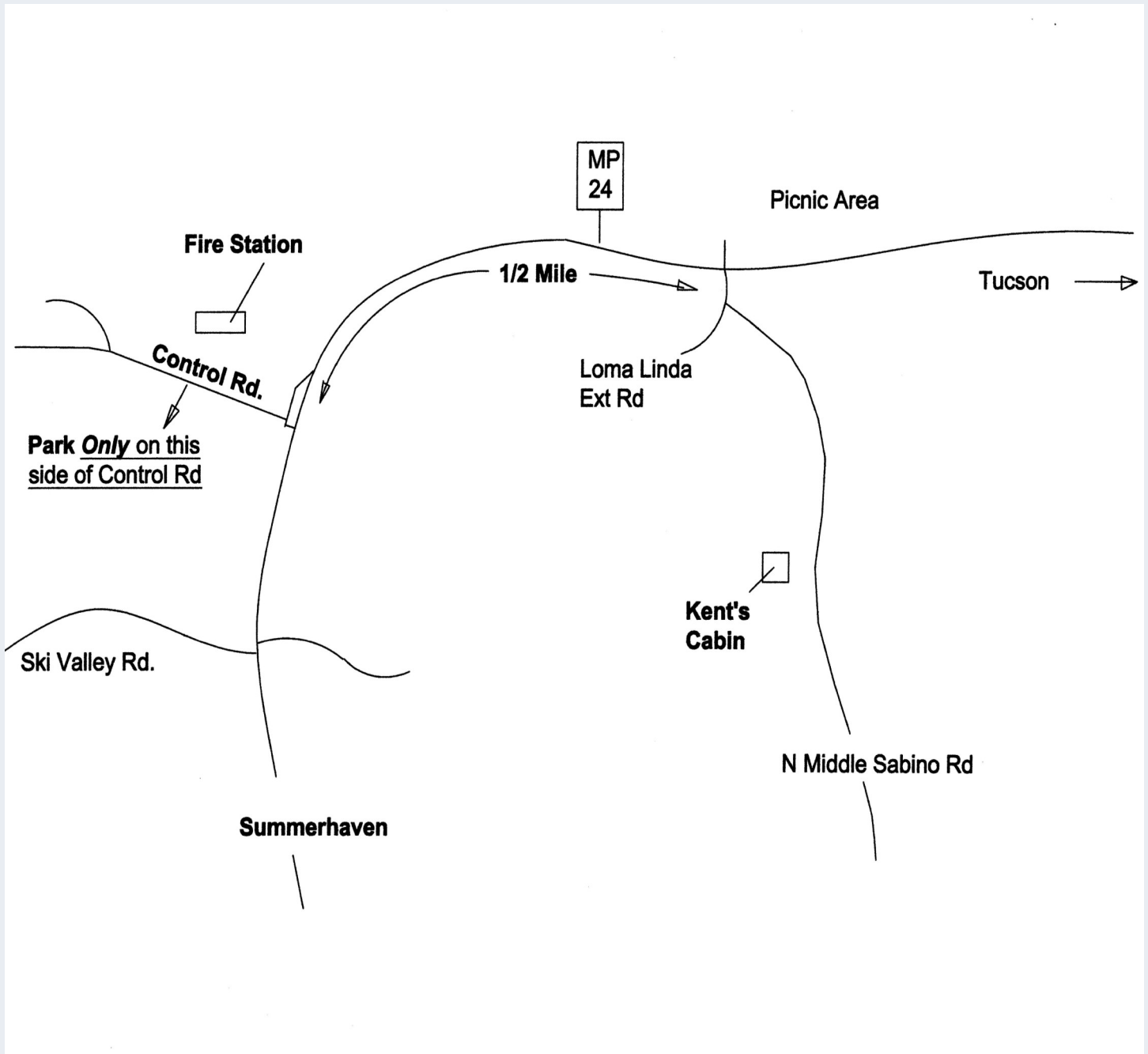
The site is named

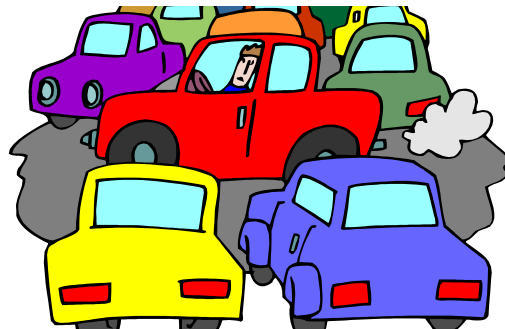


Upcoming Events!

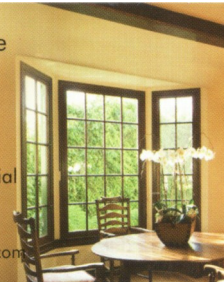
