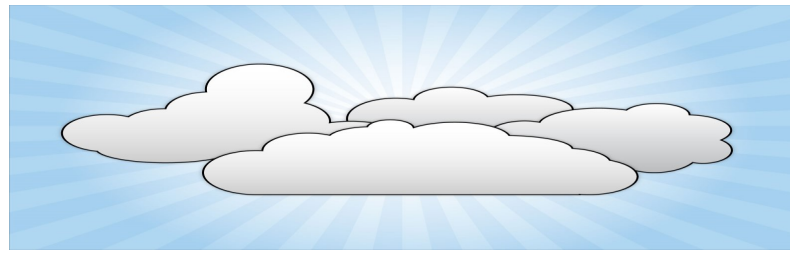


Fellowship Square September 13, 2014

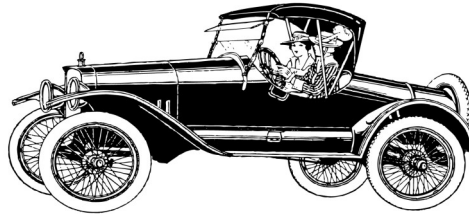

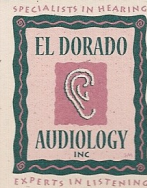

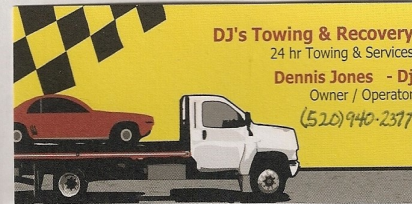
