Sunday, October 25

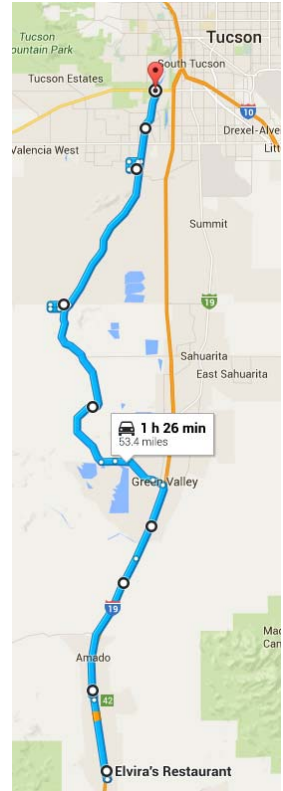
Tubac and Tumacácori

Sunday, October 25

(continued from previous page)

Directions:

1. Drive south on Mission Road to the end of the road (25.7 miles) and turn left onto Duval Mine Road;
2. Drive just under 1 mile and turn right onto Continental Road;
3. Drive about 3 miles and turn right onto the Frontage Road;
4. Drive to the end of the Frontage Road and turn left to the entrance ramp onto I-19;
5. Leave I-19 at the Chavez Siding exit (exit 40), cross under the interstate and follow the Frontage Road south to Tubac. (Distance from Continental Road to Tubac is approx. 13 miles). We will turn left into Elvira's parking lot (2221 I-19 Frontage Rd. A-101) and park the cars in a line in the area marked off by the orange cones and yellow tape.



Mission Tumacácori was established in 1691 by Jesuit padre Eusebio Kino in a different, nearby location. It was established one day before Mission Los Santos Ángeles de Guevavi, making Tumacácori the oldest Jesuit mission site in southern Arizona. The first Tumacácori mission was named Mission San Cayetano de Tumacácori. It was established at an existing native O'odham or Sobaipuri settlement on the east side of the Santa Cruz River.

After the Pima rebellion of 1751, the mission was moved to the present site on the west side of the Santa Cruz River and renamed San José de Tumacácori. By 1848, the mission was abandoned and began falling into severe disrepair. In 1854, it became a part of the U.S. Arizona Territory as a result of the Gadsden Purchase.

Restoration and stabilization efforts began in 1908 when the site was declared Tumacácori National Monument by President Theodore Roosevelt. In 1990 it became part of the new Tumacácori National Historical Park.

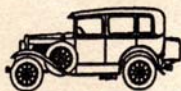

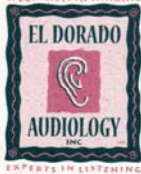


