


## Breakfast in the Park Sunday May 26

As of late April, the approximate number of tour registrations was 250. One "registration" usually means two people and one Model A. The Tucson A's account for at least 10 of those registrations.

This is a spoke & hub event where we spend each night in Kanab (hub) and visit area National Parks during the day. 
