Flag Day is June 14th.

[found in *The MotoMeter*, Diablo A's]

- * The flag to the right is the flag during the Model A era. (Note only 38 stars.) This flag flew from July 4, 1912 to July 3, 1949.
- * Congress passed the first Flag Act on June 14, 1777 in order to establish an official flag for the new nation.
- * The first American flag was called the Grand Union.
- * The first Flag Day observance was held in Philadelphia, PA in 1893.
- * President Harry S Truman proclaimed June 14 as the official U.S. Flag Day in 1949.
- * A vexillologist is an expert in the history of flags.
- * The American flag first flew in a foreign country in 1805 over Fort Deerna, on the shores of Tripoli (Libya) during the first Barbary War.
- * The only time it is appropriate to fly the flag upside down is in an emergency. It means "Help me! Call the police! I'm in dire trouble and need immediate help!"
- * The American flag has changed designs 27 times, more than any other flag in the world.
- * It takes 64 pieces of fabric to make an American flag.
- * The colors of the American flag are symbolic. Red symbolizes hardiness and valor, white symbolizes purity and innocence, and blue represents vigilance, perseverance and justice.

break, to join us. There was also some roses that was distributed to the ladies of the club to honor them on Mother's Day.

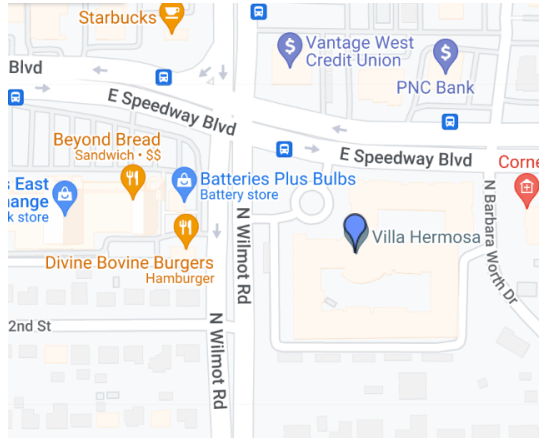
