

Overnight Trip to Globe

FRIDAY - October 21st

Leave from the Catalina Plaza just north of Sunnyside Cafe, 15800 N Oracle at 9:30 AM. We recommend Sunnyside Cafe for breakfast, great food and good service.

Proceeding north on Arizona 77 we go through Mammoth, an old-time mining town to the junction of Aravaipa Creek and the San Pedro River. We will drive about 4 miles up Aravaipa Road, stop and stretch for viewing and discuss the history of this area.

Return to Arizona 77 and stop at Winkelman for gas, restrooms and snacks. We will tour Winkelman, Hayden, San Pedro, old mining towns and discuss local history, then return to Arizona 77. Continue to the top of Pinal Pass, a good highway but steep near the top. Make sure your cooling system is good and brakes adjusted.

Continuing to Globe we will check into our hotel, Days Inn, 1630 E. Ash Street, Globe 85501. Phone **928-425-5500** for reservations under Model A Tour Group. The afternoon is open to check our cars, nap or sit and visit. We may be tired. Dinner choices can be Bistro (American), Bloom (Asian), La Casita (Mexican), or several others.

SATURDAY - October 22nd

Tour the Old Dominion Park, a preserved mine that operated from 1880 to 1931. It is free with 3 miles of trails for anyone who wants to hike.

-- Lunch suggestions: Copper Bistro, Judy's Cookhouse.

SATURDAY afternoon - visit Besh Ba Gown Archaeological Park and Museum, Courthouse, for the Globe/Gila Museum and antique shops. You may enjoy the Pickle Barrel Trading Post that has the best selection of Southwest jewelry, turquoise, pottery and vintage items. *While downtown look for dozens of cat murals painted by a local artist.

SATURDAY evening - dinner at any one of the local restaurants, or social time at the motel. Apache Gold Casino is about 10 miles east on Arizona 60 with a buffet/steakhouse but it does get dark early and you would want to be there at opening time, 4 pm. (928-475-7685).

SUNDAY— October 23rd Morning - visit sites you may have missed. We will check our cars & return to Tucson.
