MARCH OUTING – HF COORS



On Thursday, March 9, 2023 the Model A and T Clubs arrived at HF Coors where we displayed our vehicles outside the factory fences. Greg, the manager, told us about the various restaurants here in Tucson and throughout the US that use their products, including mugs for Air Force One. We then proceeded with the tour. The clay, paint and glazes are all mixed in the factory. We watched as workers placed the clay onto molds, trimmed the pieces and placed them on racks. The pieces then went onto be re-wet and all excess clay was removed. From there the pieces were stamped with the HF Coors logo. All completed pieces are air dried and then readied for firing in the enormous kiln. After firing, depending upon the piece, they were either hand-painted or had decals applied, which we were able to observe. Depending upon the pieces they may have been glazed and put back into the kiln. All pieces are inspected for any defects and should there be any these pieces are sold as seconds. The products in the store included place settings, serving pieces, cups, mugs and ornaments. After the tour we went onto BJ's for a yummy lunch. We had over 40 members who attended the tour. Those who ordered mugs were able to pick them up easily as they were already wrapped, bagged and ready to go, and of course we were able to purchase other items as well. We appreciate the wonderful turnout and hope all enjoyed the day.

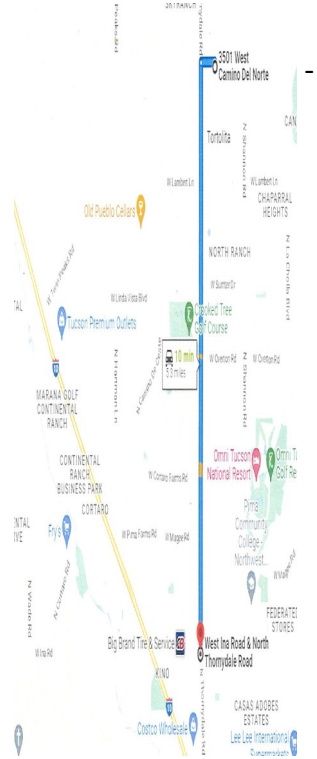


