Outside food and beverages are not permitted. There are traditional water fountains and touch-less water bottle refill station around the grounds

No pets allowed.

Once I turn in a count, we are hopeful the Event Specialist will get the approval for an area to be roped off for our vehicles. So we must stay together as a group to the Desert Museum parking area and to the entrance so you can receive your tickets.

Following is what we have planned:

Meet at the credit union at 8:15am. Raptor Free Flight (it is a must see). It starts at 10am, but you should be at one of the two places that are set up to watch them by 9:30am. The place marked "Raptor Free Flight" at the top of the map is the best place if you want to be close. The handlers stand next to the fence where they swoop down for their food and land on the cactus/bushes. The other place is #8(Cat Canyon) at the Ramada area. The owls will fly down below and ravens fly up above. There is no guarantee what species will fly, but you may see birds of prey like Chihuahuan Ravens, Great Horned Owls, Caracaras, Red-tailed Hawks, Gray hawks, and Harris's Hawks. The Caracaras are relatively new to the area. Enjoy the grounds and find you way to the Ironwood Terraces Restaurant for lunch (around 11). We hope to have an area roped off for our group to enjoy lunch together. Attend the live animal show at 12:30 in the Warden Oasis Theatre. After the Theatre, everyone can walk around at their own pace taking in the string-ray touch (if you wish) and the 2 galleries along with the rest of the museums and sculptures.

Fun things to see and do that are not on a time schedule and not part of the walking trails: Glass in Flight

Beautiful sculptures throughout the grounds. The remaining Dalle de Verre glass sculptures are on permanent display, scattered around the museum.

Ironwood Gallery—Artists for Conservation—an International exhibit of Nature in Art . Great display!! Make sure you look the items that are 4 sale and printed by a 3d printer.

Baldwin Gallery—Artful Connections. An art show that Celebrates and Appreciates the artistic abilities of the Desert Museum staff members.

And of course the nice/book shops on the way out!!!


