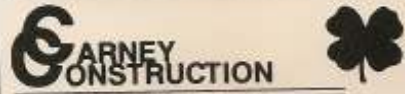

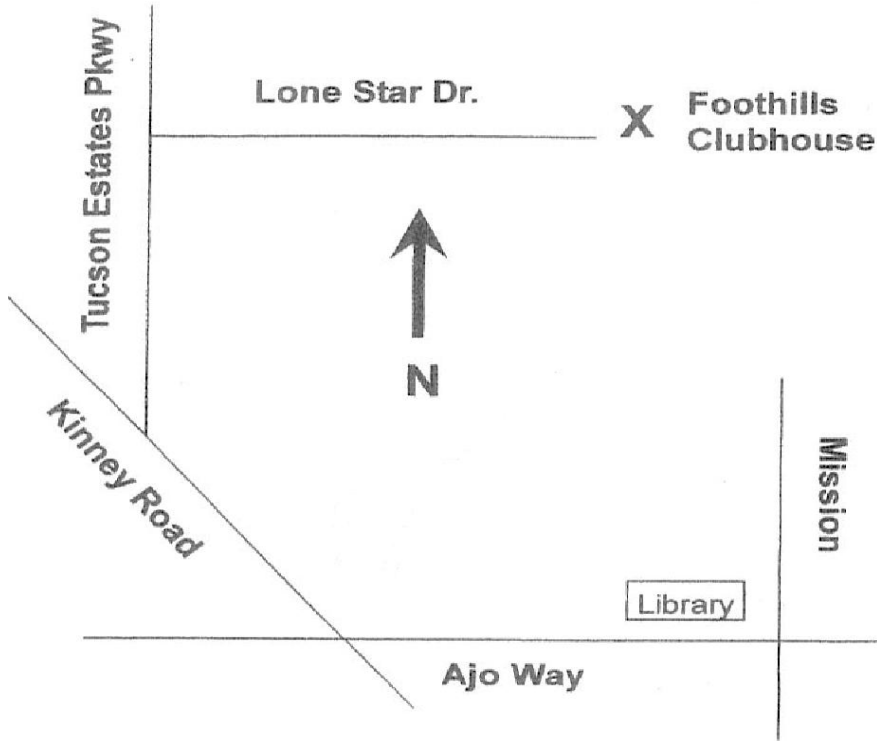

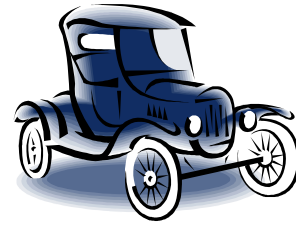


## **OLD PUEBLO NEWS DILLINGER DAYS**
