Pendleton Oregon Model A Convention

The Tucson Model A Club members trailered 6 cars to Pendleton, Oregon for the 2026 National Convention in early June for a week of driving, sightseeing and great food. Pendleton is the home of the famous Pendleton Round Up held in the early fall of each year. The weather was perfect, cool in the mornings and just right in the afternoon.

The first Model A drive was in southeastern Washington near Walla Walla with a visit to a state of the art fish hatchery where literally millions of fish are raised from spawning to almost adult fish. Mature fish are injected with a tracking device to allow the hatchery to know how many fish return to their place of birth. The next stop was a small farm with a very large collection of restored gas pumps. We are all impressed with quality of the restoration of each pump by the farm owner.

The next day was free to explore the town of Pendleton and the many western shops and restaurants with real cowboy food.

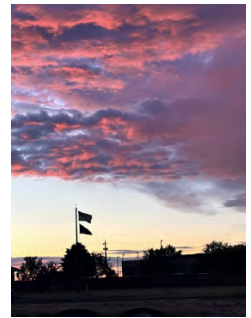

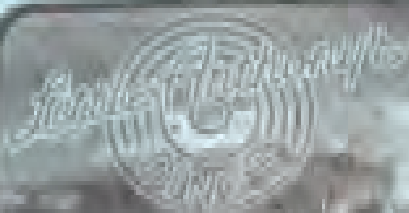
Several members took part in the Hubley car races on Wednesday evening. Maybe our Hubleys need warmer weather to loosen the wheels!

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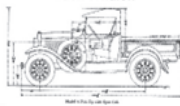
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
